



Olomouc Region GASTRONOMY

The rich agricultural tradition is the basis for the gastronomic delicacies for which the Olomouc Region is famous. "Olomoucké tvarůžky" is the flagship of all Czech cheeses and you can taste them prepared in many different ways here. The "tvarůžky" is inseparable from good beer, which has a centuries-old tradition of brewing in the region as well. Every major town has its own brewery, so exploring here also means tasting. The Haná region is also home to fruit spirits. Did you know that Prostějov is home to the oldest continuously operating distillery in Europe?



BREWERIES

1. Holba Brewery (museum)

Go on an excursion with tasting to the Holba Brewery in Hanušovice. You will discover the secret of the popular beer, which lies in the use of water from its own borehole, Moravian malt and hops from Tršice area. You will also find a stylish restaurant and a museum mapping the history of brewing in Hanušovice since 1874.



2. Litovel Brewery

You can peek under the hood of Litovel brewers during an excursion to the Litovel Brewery. You will see for yourself how the best quality ingredients help to create the popular foamy drink, as well as how the brewhouse boiling pot, the fermentation room or the lager cellars look like. It also includes a tasting of different types of Litovel beers.

3. Zubr Brewery

Every weekday in Přerov you can go on a tour of the local Zubr Brewery, which relies on traditional production methods. You just need to book in advance. The tour also includes a yeast beer tasting and there is a stylish restaurant on the premises called Pivovar.



4. Chomout Brewery

A small craft brewery in Chomoutov on the outskirts of Olomouc is located in an old farmhouse, which gives the place a magical atmosphere. In addition to lagers, the design-original pub with a spacious garden also offers interesting top-fermented beers and seasonal specials.



5. Jadrniček Brewery

The 400-year tradition of brewing beer in Náměšť na Hané is continued by the Jadrniček Brewery. The master brewer follows traditional methods and all beers are unpasteurized and unfiltered. You can taste and buy the beers in the pub on the brewery premises.



6. U Ječmínka Brewery

The craft microbrewery Ječmínek, located in the centre of Prostějov, relies on traditional brewing without pasteurization and filtration. It offers five types of beer, which you can taste in the restaurant on the brewery premises. A wide range of traditional food is also waiting for you in a pleasant environment.

7. Moritz Brewery and Restaurant

The true atmosphere of a brewery from the beginning of the 20th century is offered by the Moritz Brewery and Restaurant in the centre of Olomouc. The restaurant with its wooden furniture and floors will transport you back a hundred years and the delicious

unfiltered beer, made from local malt, straight from the tank and traditional Czech cuisine will satiate all your senses.

8. Raková Craft Brewery

Brewed with love, tuned to thirst, this is the wisdom of the Raková microbrewery near Konice. With the unmistakable crayfish on the label, it has five beers in its permanent offer, complemented by non-alcoholic Elderberry Lemonade. They are on sale at the brewery's headquarters or in the Prostějov branch.

9. Pivovar and Apartments Albert, Sobotín Resort

The Albert Chateau Brewery produces beer of the highest quality in two variants - light lager 11 and 12. You can taste the golden beverage not only in the brewery, but also in other establishments of the Sobotín Resort, such as the Klein, Sidonie or Josef Hotels.



10. Zlosin Brewery

The small family-run Zlosin Brewery continues the long tradition of brewing beer in Velké Losiny, which dates back to the 16th century. A permanent offer of beers is available in the brewery premises with outdoor seating on the edge of the village, in the Zlosin Beer Bar in nearby Rapotín and other pubs in the vicinity.



11. TVARG Brewery

The modern TVARG Brewery and the artisanal production of tvarůžky under the name Tvargle, this is the mix offered in Velká Bystřice near Olomouc. In addition to traditional lagers, they brew up to twenty beer specials during the year, which guests can taste in the restaurant, where Tvargle and all products are on sale.

REGIONAL PRODUCTS

12. Olomouc "Tvarůžky" Cheese

You can learn all about the rich history and traditional production of the only original Czech cheese at the A.W. Olomouc "Tvarůžky" Museum in Loštice. At the end of the tour you can visit the company shop of the tvarůžky cheese producer A.W. with a complete assortment of this renowned aromatic delicacy.



13. Tvarůžky Cheese Confectionery Loštice

Those who have not visited the Tvarůžky Cheese Confectionery in Loštice cannot claim to know our only original cheese perfectly. Only here you can taste tvarůžky cream-roll, Loštice cake with jam and other unique desserts made from Olomouc tvarůžky cheese.

14. Chocolate Factory Troubelice

A small, family-run chocolate factory that selects the finest ingredients imported directly from Ecuador for its chocolate production. You can taste and buy all the products directly in the chocolate shop in the chocolate factory, where you can sit with a cup of Ecuadorian coffee, hot chocolate or cool down with delicious ice cream in the summer. Children will also have fun in the outdoor garden.



15. Blueberry Dumplings, Mountain Chalet Paprsek

The dumplings with a generous filling of blueberries from the local forests can be enjoyed throughout the Jeseníky Mountains. The Paprsek Mountain Chalet is especially famous for its production, where the dumplings are served sprinkled with cocoa and drizzled with melted butter. Paprsek is also an ideal base for hiking in the summer and skiing in the winter.



16. Velké Losiny Pralines

Out of her love for chocolate and confectionery, Jana Kašparová established a unique workshop in Velké Losiny, where handmade Velké Losiny pralines are made. Visitors can taste them in the company's confectionery or at the Chocolate Losiny festival, which is regularly held at the end of September.

17. Staré Město Butter Roll

Originally, Olga Gřundelová made the rolls for herself and friends, but as her fame spread around the area, she founded a professional factory in Staré Město. Here, the famous Staroměstské butter rolls have been produced for 25 years. You can taste them in the company's Confectionery U zámku in Branná.

18. Lavender Farm Bezděkov

The lavender farm in Bezděkov will transport you to French Provence. Take a look at the lavender exposition with a shop full of handmade products from this fragrant herb. Throughout the year, various events are held on the estate, the biggest being the Lavender Festival every 5th and 6th July.



19. Via Delicia

The family-run Via Delicia cannery in Zábřeh offers guided tastings by reservation, a production tour and a company shop with a full range of renowned gastronomic delicacies. It relies on tried-and-tested old recipes, which it combines with modern preserving technologies.



20. Brazzale Moravia

A cheese factory that has managed to combine Italian technology and Czech agricultural quality to perfection. The flagship product is the extra hard Gran Moravia cheese, but the cheese factory also offers many other dairy products, which can be purchased in the company's La Formaggeria Gran Moravia stores (in the Olomouc region, for example, in Litovel - Tři Dvory directly on the company's premises, in Olomouc or in Prostějov).



21. Otínoves Dairy

Milk with a high protein and fat content from dairy cows from the Moravian Karst and Drahanská vrchovina is the basis for the production of the renowned Niva cheese in Otínoves. Even today it is made by hand. You can buy Niva and other dairy products for a good price in the local shop.

DISTILLERIES

22. U Zeleného stromu Distillery

The oldest continuously operating distillery in Europe is located in Prostějov and called U Zeleného stromu. You will be introduced to the production of "Stará Mysivecká" rye whisky and other products by an excursion to the bottling line and the oak barrels in which the spirits are aged. There is also a tasting and a visit to the company shop.



23. Tōsh Distillery

The Tōsh family distillery continues the rich tradition of spirits production in Těšetice, which dates back to the 16th century, and revives the past glory of the Czechoslovak whisky King Barley and the herbal liqueur Jakamarus. During the tour you will discover the historical and contemporary distillery premises, and the tasting will tickle your palate.

24. Jeseníky Ullersdorf Distillery

The Jeseníky liqueur and distillery Ullersdorf produces original herbal liqueurs and noble fruit spirits of top quality. It is located in the ancient Maršikov mill near Velké Losiny. During the excursion, they will reveal the secrets of liqueur production, and you will finish the tour with a tasting of selected products.

25. Likérka Domašov (Bairnsfather Family Distillery)

The bitter medicinal herbs typical of the Jeseníky Mountains, the best quality alcohol and mountain spring water are used to create exceptional liqueurs in Bělá pod Pradědem. The Bairnsfather Family Distillery is renowned mainly for its absinthe production, but a complete range is available for purchase.



Taste Moravia on a Bike

The Taste Moravia on a Bike Route is a trip and a gourmet experience wrapped together as it crosses the Mohelnice and Zábřeh regions. It is 91 kilometres long and offers a variety of options to adapt the length to your fitness and taste buds. At 13 stops, choose from delicacies from family farms, patisseries and cafés.
