

ing castles in the Czech Republic, Bouzov was founded at the beginning of the 14th century. Its current appearance as a romantic seat is due to an extensive renovation that took place from 1895-1910. Its two functional drawbridges and portcullis are unique. Visitors may choose from several thematic guided tours. Šternberk Castle

This Gothic castle was founded by the Šternberk noble family in the 2nd half of the 13th century. The castle was then extended in the Late-Gothic style, and completed in the Renaissance style in the 16th century. The castle was last owned by the Lichtenstein family who rebuilt the castle in the spirit of historicized Romanticism. The castle interiors will surprise you

by their generosity and rich collection of works of art originating from across Europe - unique collections of Italian and Nordic Early-Renaissance paintings, a collection of tiled stoves from the Renaissance to the Empire style periods, and objects from the life of modern aristocracy at the beainning of the 20th century.

Helfštýn Castle

One of the most extensive medieval castles, its construction began at the beginning of the 14th century. The Pernštejn family became its owners in 1475, and they expanded and fortified the castle. In the 17th century, the castle became the possession of Cardinal Franz Seraph von Dietrichstein, who scaled back some of the castle's perimeter, and Helfstýn Castle was no longer a mansion. The castle's current appearance is that of an extensive fort with six gates, several towers, and an earthwork system dating back to the 18th century. The castle plays host to many cultural events, one of which and by the most popular is the international meeting of artistic smiths called "Hefaiston", which eniovs a permanent exhibition at the castle.

Náměšť na Hané Chateau

This Early-Classicist chateau is situated in the middle of a circular park and was built by Ferdinand Bonaventura, Earl of Harrach, in the second half of the 18th century. Its Rococo interiors contain exhibitions presenting the lifestyle of high aristocracy and fine arts. The valuable collection of Meissen porcelain and the exhibition of historical children's prams are also worth visiting.



The construction of this Early-Mannerist chateau located on the former site of a 13th-century castle was launched by Jan Adam of Lichtenstein in 1680. Out of four intended grandiose wings, just one was built. The front that is divided by massive columns is remarkably impressive. Every year, the chateau plays host to music and theatre festivals and workshops with international participants.

The original fortress from the 14th century has gone through several transformations over the centuries. In the 16th century, the Pernštein family made a decisive change to the chateau in the Early-Renaissance spirit. The dominant area of the chateau is its nearly one hundred-metretall tower called the Graceful Tower Other places of interest include the unique Renaissance tower portal, a replica of the staircase in the Vienna Opera House, and the knight and gathering halls. Also worth visiting are the exhibition devoted to the Prussia-Austria battle of Toyačov in 1866 and the exhibition devoted to Ctibor Tovačovský of Cimburk.

At the beginning of the 18th century, the original fortress was rebuilt into a four-wing Baroque chateau. An important era in its history began with the arrival of the Portuguese Silva-Taroucca family, who owned the chateau from 1768 to the end of the Second World War. The building got its current Classicist appearance in the middle of the 19th century. At the same time, the original Baroque garden was also extended and modified into a natural landscape park. The park once served as a studio for the prominent Czech painter Josef Mánes, who made over one hundred works of art from 1846-1870 there.

Dřevohostice Chateau

This is a Renaissance four-wing chateau dating back to the 16th century. From 1595-1617, when the chateau was possessed by Karel Sen of Žerotín, a fundamental Renaissance renovation took place. In front of the chateau are valuable 18th-century Baroque statues by St. John of Nepomuk and St. John Sarkander. The chateau houses an exhibition of works by academic sculptor Jiří Lendr and hall that commemorates Cardinal Lev Skrbenský. The Fireman Museum is located in front of the chateau.

Hustopeče nad Bečvou Chateau

This Renaissance chateau was built for Karel Sr. of Žerotín and his son Viktorin in 1596 as a four-wing building with an arcade yard. Currently, renovation and restoration works are ongoing. For visitors, there is a lapidarium with an exhibition of well-preserved stone components of the Renaissance arcades of the chateau and the Butcher Museum that documents the tradition and development of the craft in the local family-owned company Váhala a spol.



Konice Chateau

This Baroque chateau was built between 1703 and 1705 after having been ordered by the Olomouc Premonstratensians. The western wing of the building contains the most precious area of the chateau, the former monks' dining room. The ceiling is decorated with a precious fresco entitled "Dining of St. Family", created by Jan Jiří Etgens between 1725 and 1733. Today, there is a ceremonial hall, gallery, an exhibition of customs and crafts with the largest collection of axes in the Czech Republic and an information centre.



OLOMOUC

Olomouc, the capital of Central Moravia and home to one hundred thousand inhabitants, is the administrative centre of the Olomouc Region and has been ranked among the most important towns in the Czech state for ages. Thanks to its location, long-standing university, and spiritual, cultural and craft traditions, it has been the natural centre of Moravia for several centuries and has attracted artists, intellectuals and merchants. Today, it is the second largest conservation area in the Czech Republic after Prague, and boasts a number of historical and architectural gems, among them a UNESCO-listed memorial (The Holy Trinity Column). Thanks to its atmosphere, Olomouc is a popular centre for many cultural, social and sports events. The Flora Olomouc international gardening exhibition has existed for more than forty years. Popular events include the Autumn Festival of Sacred Music and The International Organ Festival. More recent events also have their fans – Beerfest, The Flamenco Festival, and The Olomouc Half Marathon. Several opportunities to relax are provided by large parks full of greenery, a modern agua park, swimming pool, and large zoo on Holy Hill. The internationally-respected travel guide Lonely Planet has repeatedly declared Olomouc to be the most beautiful town in the Czech Republic and is one the fifty hidden treasures in Europe.

THE UPPER SOUARE AND SURROUNDINGS

Holy Trinity Column

This unique sculptural work built from 1716–1754 was initiated by Václav Render. It is 32m tall and there is a chapel in the bottom section. The column was listed in the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage in 2000.

The bottom section of The Holy Trinity Column hides a chapel that is seasonally open. A guide is available from Tuesdays to Saturdays 9am – 5pm during the summer season.



Town Hall and the Astronomical Clock 🔊

The Town Hall is the dominant feature of the Upper Square (Horní náměstí). A bay window from St. Jerome Chapel projects from the southern facade and a Renaissance loggia can be found on the eastern side. Objects of interest include the Olomouc astronomical clock, whose current appearance reflects socialist realism; it was based on a design by K. Svolinský. The Town Hall building contains an exhibition of the town's history, the astronomical clock and the Town Hall.



All exhibitions are freely accessible during the magistrate's working hours and within the "Olomouc in a Nutshells with a Guide" tours, which also allows you the opportunity to climb the Town Hall's tower. The astronomical clock runs every day beginning at 12pm.

Caesar Fountain

Caesar Fountain is the most popular and artistically-unique fountain in Olomouc. Its sculptures present the town's great founder – Gaius Julius Caesar.



St. Maurice Church

The church is one of the most valuable buildings in the Late-Gothic style in Moravia. This real unique structure includes a Late-Gothic sculptural group called Christ on the Mount of Olives from the mid-15th century located by the church's southern wall. The organ, which dates back to 1745, was made by Michael Engler, the master from Vratislav.

Mercury Fountain

The Mercury Fountain from 1727 is considered to the best artistically of all the Olomouc Baroque fountains.

Hercules Fountain

This fountain from 1687 is decorated with a statue of the fabulous ancient hero Hercules.

Arion Fountain

This fountain from 2002 completes the group of Olomouc Baroque fountains inspired by ancient mythology. It was built by a famous Olomouc native living in France, sculptor Ivan Theimer.

THE LOWER SQUARE

Neptune Fountain

This fountain from 1683 shows Neptune, the Roman God of the Sea.

Marian Column

The Marian Column is the dominant feature of the Lower Square (Dolní náměstí). It was built after a plague epidemic in Olomouc (1713 – 1715) and was initiated by stonemason Václav Render.

Jupiter Fountain

This fountain is the last of the Olomouc Baroque fountains (1735).

TOWARDS WENCESLAUS SQUARE

St. Michael Church

The oldest mention of it dates back to 1260; the new Baroque building was built by G. P. Tencalla between 1676 and 1699. The accessible areas include the cloister, St. Alexius Chapel, the Paradisiacal Yard with a children's play area, the cellar vault with an underground lake and hermitage and the tower with a parish museum.

St. John Sarkander Chapel

On the site of this Neo-Baroque chapel, a town jail where priest John Sarkander was interrogated and tortured to death in 1620 once stood; he was canonized by Pope John Paul II in 1995. It was rebuilt into its current appearance by architect E. Sochor between 1909 and 1912.









Villa Primavesi

This Art-Nouveau-style villa of Viennese origin is based on an English layout. There is a restaurant in the building.

Our Lady of the Snows Church

This Baroque church was built in 1712 as part of the Jesuit University. In 1778, it was passed over to the administration of the Olomouc garrison; it was temporarily used as a barracks and a warehouse. Religious services were resumed at the beginning of the 20th century. The interior decorations were created by K. J. Harringer, J. K. Handke, J. Thomasberger, and J. Sturmer.

The fountain was built after the town fire in 1707.


Archbishop Palace

This magnificent Early-Baroque palace has been the seat of Olomouc bishops and archbishops since its inception, Austrian Emperor Franz Joseph I, among others, was crowned there. It is currently the only archbishop's seat in central Europe accessible to the public.



Olomouc Castle

This former castle of the Premyslid family has been a national cultural monument since 1962. The Olomouc Castle, considerably modified by later additions and renovations, is located on Wenceslaus Hillock. The most important parts of the castle are the Gothic St. Wenceslaus Cathedral and the partly-preserved Romanesque Bishop's Palace with architecturally valuable window openings.

SACRAL MONUMENTS

Central Moravia is one of the most popular destinations for supporters of spiritual traditions in the Czech Republic. The largest concentration of sacred monuments can be found in Olomouc (10–11); however, sites of appreciable religious importance are found throughout the region. Set out to explore Jewish settlements and pilgrimage sites. An architectural gem, the pilgrimage basilica on Holy Hill, dominates the Olomouc area and is visited not only by pilgrims, but also admirers of Baroque beauty.

The temple of the Visitation of the Virgin Mary on Holy Hill is one of the most well-known and popular pilgrimage sites in the Czech Republic. It was built by the Premonstratensians in the 17th and 18th centuries on the site of a chapel that was destroyed by the Swedes. According to legend, the pilgrimage site was founded by Olomouc burgher and wine merchant Jan Andrýsek, when he built a chapel that was demanded of him by the Virgin Mary in a dream. The interior decorations were created by a number of domestic and foreign artists. Jan Kryštof Handke painted the dome pendentives with allegories of four continents. The St. Augustin Chapel contains an altar painting also by J. K. Handke, which is considered to be one of the painter's best works. Pope John Paul II promoted the temple to basilica minor in 1995.



St. Anne Pilgrimage Church



This is an important pilgrimage site with an emotional history situated in the Libavá military domain. The history of pilgrimages to Stará Voda on the St. Anne feast dates back to the beginning of the 16th century.

Main pilgrimages

• Prisoners' pilgrimage takes place on the first Saturday in June. The main pilgrimage takes place on Saturday and Sunday after St. Anne's feast (26 July). Another pilgrimage usually takes place on Sunday around the Assumption of the Virgin Mary feast (15 August) and on Sunday around the Nativity of Virgin Mary feast (08 September).

Pilgrimage Church of the Purification of the Virgin Mary

According to legend, people came to the Baroque temple of the Purification of the Virgin Mary and admired a wooden picture of the Virgin Mary that shined at night. The church was built by architect Klíčník between 1734 and 1756. In 1731, the Marian Residence that provided accommodation to auxiliary priests was built beside the temple. The building was later connected with the church by a wall, and now it serves as a vicarage. In the surroundings of the temple are several large Baroque sculptural groups, including statues of St. Florian, St. John of Nepomuk and St. Joseph.



Church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary

This originally Gothic temple was rebuilt into its current Neo-Gothic appearance in the second half of the 19th century. The church has a nave, transept and presbytery coming from the original Gothic temple.

St. Liborius Church

The church, together with the castle, are part of the unique Baroque complex of buildings. The gem of the temple is the altar that dates back to the beginning of the 18th century and contains carvings shaped as like a spread baldachin. Giovanni Tencalla was most probably the architect of the building, and St. Libor Church was supposed to be a simplified version of Tencalla's unrealized project for the Jesuit church of Our Lady of the Snows in Olomouc.

Church of the Visitation of the Virgin Mary

This Baroque pilgrimage church was founded thanks to a small well called Holy Water where, according to legend, miraculous recoveries occurred. In 1766, a chapel was built over the well as a presbytery for a future temple. The church was completed between 1807 and 1810. The church's current appearance comes from 1905-1910, when a tower and temple front with statues were added. The original spring rises under the main altar and is led outside the church to the water chapel.

JEWISH MONUMENTS


Follow in the footsteps of Jewish settlements in Central Moravia and learn the turbulent history of this region. Although from the 13th to the mid-19th centuries, the Jews were pushed into ghettos, they created a vital culture, which still impresses visitors with its uniqueness and its palatable mystique. Moravia's oldest preserved synagogue (the second oldest in the Czech Republic) and two Jewish cemeteries can be found in **Lipník nad Becvou**. The nearby synagogue in **Hranice** was built in the Moorish-Byzantine style and is now used as an exhibition hall and a concert hall. Former Jewish temples and cemeteries can be found in **Přerov** and **Kojetín**. The **Tovacov** Funeral Hall in the Jewish cemetery, which was designed by architect Max Fleischer, is decorated with Hebrew inscriptions and serves as a small museum featuring an exhibition of Jewish burial rites and the history of the Jewish community in **Tovacov**. Significant Jewish settlement were also built in **Úsov** and **Loštice**, as evidenced by surviving synagogues and Jewish cemeteries. The pews in Loštice's synagogue are a symbolic memorial to Holocaust victims from **Loštice**, **Mohelnice**. **Úsov** and **Litovel**.

Interesting fact

Due to the lack of space, it is not orientated towards Jerusalem, but to the east.









MUSEUMS

There are several interesting museums in the Central Moravian region. One especially unique example is the Archdiocesan Museum, where you can become acquainted with the fine arts culture of the Olomouc archdiocese over the previous millennium. Unconventional exhibitions can be found at the Museum of Olomouc Tvaruzky (tvaruzky is a mature fragrant cheese) in Loštice, the Exhibition of Time in Šternberk, and the Museum of Historic Carriages in Cechy pod Kosířem.

Archdiocesan Museum

The permanent exhibition at the museum acquaints visitors with the spiritual culture of the Olomouc Archdiocese. In the gallery of art are top paintings that have been collected by Olomouc bishops since the 16th century.

NATURAL SITES

Set out on the trail and take in the natural wealth of Central Moravia! You will walk a varied mosaic of the ecosystem along streams, through meadows with diverse species and alluvial forests in the unique Litovelské Pomoraví Protected Landscape Area, which plays home to a number of rare plants and animals. Discover various cave systems in Javoříčko, Mladeč and Teplice nad Bečvou, and spare a moment for relaxing at local arboreta and parks. Central Moravia also offers its visitors several dozens of nature trails with low or medium demands that invite you to take quiet walks connected with learning and magical views of the surroundings.

Hranice Abyss



The Hranice Abyss is the deepest abyss in the Czech Republic and the second deepest flooded abyss in the world. The dry part of the abyss is 69.5m deep; however, the majority of the space is below the surface of the water. The current depth of the abyss is 384 m, but its bottom has not yet been reached. The abyss was probably created by the collapse of the cave ceilings that had existed in the local limestone block.

Zbrašov Aragonite Caves

The Zbrašov Aragonite Caves lie in a river valley near the Teplice nad Bečvou spa and the Hranice Abyss. It is a unique cave system of European importance that arose due to the concurrent effect of atmospheric water and warm mineral water. Its unique appearance comes from the mineral aragonite. These are the warmest caves in the Czech Republic, with a year-round stable temperature of 14 °C.

Mladeč Caves

The Mladeč Caves are situated in the Litovelské Pomoraví Protected Landscape Area. They rank among the archaeological localities of world importance. They are quite probably the oldest, largest and most northern site of modern people (Cro-Magnon) in Europe, who have been shown to have lived there more than 31,000 years ago. The caves present a very irregular labyrinth of corridors and chambers and tall chimneys with remarkably-shaped walls and ceilings, with stalactites and many block "cave-ins and several steep corridors.

It was established in 1990 in order to protect the naturally-meandering flow of the Morava River and its system of alluvial forests. A number of rare plants and animals can be found there.



Litovelského Pomoraví House of Nature

This consists of a gamekeepers' lodge and Šargoun garden near Litovel, and an outdoor exhibition near the Sluňákov Centre for Ecological Activities in Horka nad Moravou. Šargoun is a low-energy building that houses an apiculture exhibition of and serves as an information point where you get basic information about the protected landscape area through games or 3D technologies. Sluňákov contains an exhibition entitled "Seven Gates to the Mystery of Litovelské Pomoraví", which is composed of small architectural elements that were designed by outstanding Czech artists.

BICYCLE TOURING

Central Moravia is a diverse region interlinked by routes suitable for bicycle touring, in-line skate lovers and scooter fans. There you will find more than 200km of adapted and clearly marked bicycle routes lined with natural and historically valuable gems. Two key European bicycle routes, **Eurovelo 4** and **Eurovelo 9**, **run through Central Moravia**. Important bicycle routes include the **Bečva bicycle route**, which partially copies Eurovelo 4, and the **Moravian route**, which largely overlaps both European bicycle routes. Long-distance and thematic regional bicycle routes offer plain sections suitable for families with children as well as very demanding sections with great elevation differences that present interesting challenges for physically fit cyclists.



Eurovelo 4

Eurovelo 4 is one of the key European bicycle routes that run through Europe from west to east. The route is four thousand kilometres long, and offers an adventurous journey from the French coast, through Belgium and Germany to the Czech Republic, and it continues on to Poland and Ukraine. The route runs through Central Moravia from Kroměříž, through Tovačov and Věrovany to Přerov, from where it is follows the Bečva bicycle route.

Eurovelo 9

This is a very popular bicycle route that is nearly 1,930km long. The route starts in Polish Gdansk and ends in the south of Croatia, in the town of Pula. In the Czech Republic, it runs through the Jeseníky Mountains, then through Olomouc to the South Moravian Region. In Central Moravia, the route runs through Mohelnice, the Litovelské Pomoraví Protected Landscape Area, the towns of Litovel and Olomouc, around Prostějov and through Protivanov onwards to Southern Moravia.

Bečva bicycle route



On the Bečva bicycle route, you will have the opportunity to learn about places of interest, natural wonders, folk traditions and local specialities of Moravian Wallachia, Moravian Gate and Haná from the springs of the Rožnovská and Vsetínská Bečva Rivers at the confluence of the Morava River. 160km of marked routes carry cyclists along the Bečva River through the Zlín Region and Central Moravia. The undemanding section of the bicycle route along the Bečva River is intended not only for cyclists, but also for hikers, and where possible, also for skaters.

The Moravian bicycle route runs from the Jeseníky Mountains to Southern Moravia. The section through Haná is ideal for less physically-fit cyclists. Its length in Central Moravia is about 80km; it connects the towns of Mohelnice, Litovel, Olomouc and Tovačov, and most of it runs through the lovely countryside of the Litovelské Pomoraví Protected Landscape Area. Using the current trail numbers, the Moravian route follows route Nos. 51 and 47.

Hvězdná (Olomouc-Šternberk)



Bicycle route 6104, which connects the towns of Olomouc and Šternberk, starts in the Olomouc neighbourhood of Chválkovice and continues through Černovír along the railway. Where it crosses Trusovický brook, the bicycle route turns aside towards Hlušovice, where it joins the bicycle route to Bohuňovice. From there, it is possible to continue along the railway through Štarnov to Šternberk.

Laudon's Bicycle Route – through the Bystrice River Valley

The bicycle route that runs through the Bystřice River Valley between Moravský Beroun and Olomouc is named after the well-known Austrian general Laudon, who destroyed a Prussian supply convoy in Domašov nad Bystřicí, thus saving Olomouc from an attack by Prussian troops.

For golf lovers, there is an 18-hole par-72 master course, a par-27 nine-hole public course, a driving range, extensive putting green, chipping green and a clubroom with a terrace. A trainer, restaurant, reception area and PRO-SHOP are also available to golfers.



Radíkov Golf Club

The diverse character of the area, small ponds, and varied slopes guarantee variety and an interesting round at this nine-hole golf course.



Prostějov Golf Resort

Aquapark Olomouc


